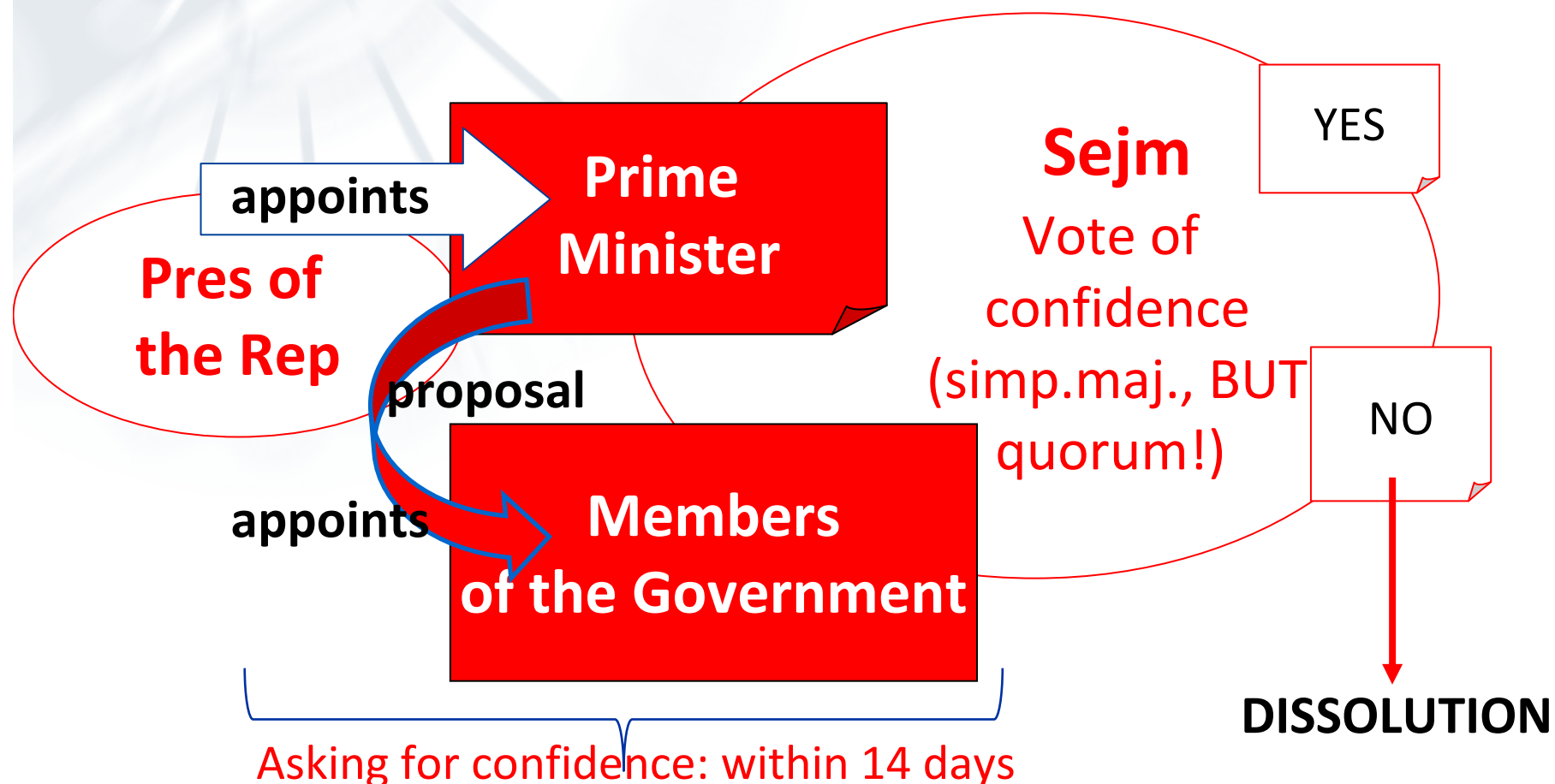

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Poland – termination of the mandate

Resignation – by the Prime Minister

- at the first sitting of a newly elected Sejm
- YES: constructive vote of no confidence
- NO: vote of confidence
- Resignation of the Prime Minister

Poland – after the crash

- Acting President (Marshal of the Sejm):
date (within fortnight) of the new election (within 60 days)
- Original date of the presidential election:
bw 19 Sept and 3 Oct 2010
- Candidates (35 y, 100000 voters):
L. Kaczynski, J. Szmajdzinski

(Senatorial by-election is reported to be on the same day)
