Croatia

- **Legislative power – Parliament**
 - one chamber (HU, CRO)
- **Executive power – Government**
 - responsible to the Parliament
 - chancellery type
- **President of the Republic**
 - representative and symbolic; „takes care of ...”
 - countersignature
 - do not part of the executive
 - elected by the Parliament (HU)
 - elected by the people (CRO)

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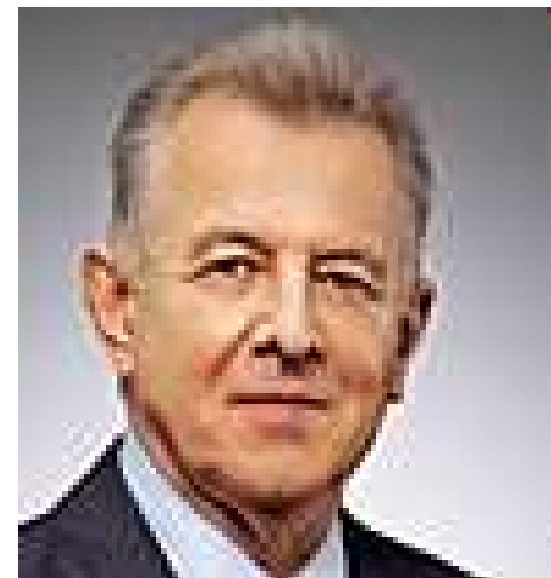
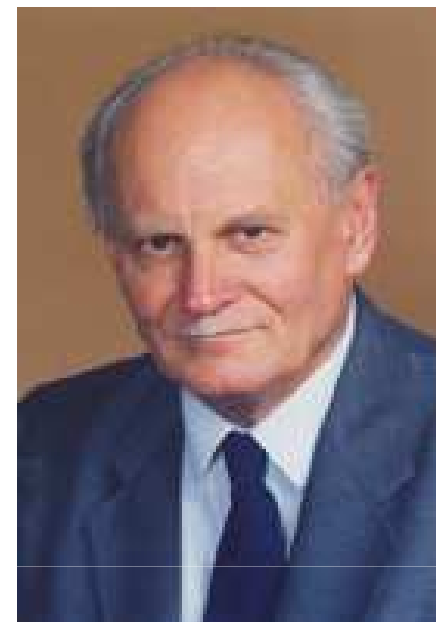
